

Regulations of the online conference "**Rape Cultivation and the European Green Deal**", which takes place during the International Day of Rape "**Eurorzepak 2021**" in Minikowo, organized by Kujawsko-Pomorski Agricultural Advisory Centre in Minikowo on behalf of the National Association of Manufacturers of Rape and Protein Crops.

§1 General terms and conditions

1. The document determines the terms and conditions of participation in the online conference "**Rape Growing and the European Green Deal**", which takes place during the International Day of Rapeseed "**Eurorzepak 2021**" in Minikowo on 20 May 2021, organized by Kujawsko-Pomorski Agricultural Advisory Centre in Minikowo, Minikowo 1, 89-122 Minikowo, NIP 558-17-42-615.
2. The conference is organized on behalf of the National Association of Rape and Protein Plant Producers.
3. The conference is financed by the Oilseed Crops Promotion Fund.
4. The conference will be held online as a webinar.
5. The participant of the conference is each adult person whose participation in the conference has been confirmed by the organizer after sending the application form.
6. Participation in the conference is free.
7. Registration form means a form available at www.eurorzepak-minikowo.pl through which the registration takes place.
8. **Conference** means an online conference organized by the Organizer, which applies to the Registration.
9. **Regulations** means hereby regulations.
10. **Registration** means the process of enrolling a Participant to participate in the Conference.
11. **Participant** means a natural person having full legal capacity, registered to participate in the Conference.
12. Registration for participation in the Conference is tantamount to accepting the terms of the Regulations.

§2 Registration and participation in the Conference

1. Registration takes place only by completing and sending the Application Form available at www.eurorzepak-minikowo.pl.
2. Technical requirements for participation in the Conference are the same as the requirements necessary to use the Internet. The participant should have a computer with software that allows browsing the Internet.

3. The deadline for submitting applications for participation in the Conference ends no later than the start of the Conference.
4. The date of receipt of the application form by the Organizer is considered the date of application.
5. Participant, by registering for the Conference online, confirms the intention to participate in the conference.
6. If the Registration is made by a person other than the Participant, he/she is responsible for the accuracy of the information provided. The Registrant should also have the authority given by the Participant to transfer to the Organizer personal data of the Participant for processing.
7. Participant may resign from participation in the Conference at any time during the Conference.
8. While making the registration application, the participant confirms to being familiar with and accepts these Regulations and agrees to participate in the Conference under the conditions specified therein, as well as agrees to the processing of personal data provided in the registration.

§3 Technical Requirements, the method of Conducting the Conference

1. The Conference is a service provided electronically by means of audio and video transmission.
2. The conduct of the Online Conference by means of electronic communication includes, in particular:
 - (a) real-time online transmission;
 - (b) real-time communication in the form described in para. 3, and in the case of speakers using a camera and microphone.
3. If the Organizer provides a chat function during the transmission of the Conference, the Participant may contact other Participants through this chat by text messages.

In order to receive the audio and video transmission of the Conference, the Participant clicks on the individual link, which will be provided by the Organizer via e-mail.

§4 Rights and obligations of the Conference Organizer

1. In the event that the Conference could not be held on the agreed date for reasons beyond the control of the Organizer, such as force majeure (an event preventing the Conference from entering independently, such as pandemics, government orders, strikes, etc.), the Organizer reserves the right to offer another deadline. In the case of a participant, the notification will be notified immediately via the address provided by the participant during the registration application.
2. The organizer reserves the right to change the Conference program, i.e. speakers, topics and hours of lectures as well as the date and place of the Conference, if the integration of due

diligence by the Organizer of the original program of the Conference proves impossible or significantly difficult to implement, e.g. due to the speaker's disease or other plant decorations beyond his control.

3. The chat available during the Conference will be moderated. This means that not all messages by question participants will appear in the public chat.

4. The course of the on-line conference will be recorded

§5 Copyright

1. The conference materials were prepared by the speakers and are copyrighted.

2. Copying, modifying, public playback and dissemination of the conference materials without the Organiser's consent is prohibited. Participants have the right to use the presented content only for personal use.

§6 Information clause

Pursuant to Art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (Journal UE L 119, s.1) - General Data Protection Regulation "GDPR" - we inform you about the rules of processing your personal data and about your related rights.

2. Your personal data is processed in order to perform the contract - application for participation in the conference entitled "Rapeseed Cultivation and the European Green Deal", which will take place on May 20, 2021.

3. The recipients of your personal data may be:

a .only entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of legal provisions;

b. entities processing data on the basis of relevant contracts signed with the National Association of Rapeseed and Protein Plants, processing personal data for which the Administrator is the National Association of Rapeseed and Protein Plants

c. Entities operating the conference entitled "Growing Rapeseed and the European Green Deal" on the basis of the entrustment agreements concluded with:

4. Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary to perform the contract and the date of its settlement and redress, i.e. 5 years after the end of the year in which the contract was performed.

5. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:

- a. right to access personal data, including the right to obtain a copy of this data;
- b. the right to request the rectification (correction) of personal data - if the data is incorrect or incomplete;
- c. the right to request the deletion of personal data (the so-called right to be forgotten), if:
 - i. the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed,
 - ii. the data subject has objected to the processing of personal data,
 - iii. the data subject has withdrawn consent to the processing of personal data, which is the basis for data processing and there is no other legal basis for data processing,
 - iv. personal data is processed unlawfully,
 - v. personal data must be removed in order to comply with the legal obligation;
- d. the right to request the restriction of the processing of personal data - if:
 - i. the data subject questions the accuracy of the personal data,
 - ii. data processing is unlawful, and the data subject opposes the deletion of data, requesting their restriction instead,
 - iii. The administrator no longer needs the data for his purposes, but the data subject needs them to establish, defend or pursue claims,
 - iv. the data subject has objected to the processing of data until it is determined whether the legitimate grounds on the part of the Administrator override the grounds of objection;
- e. the right to transfer data - if the following conditions are jointly met:
 - i. data processing takes place on the basis of an agreement concluded with the data subject or on the basis of the consent expressed by that person,
 - ii. the processing is carried out in an automated manner;
- f. the right to object to data processing.

6. If you become aware of unlawful processing of your personal data in the National Association of Producers of Rapeseed and Protein Plants, you have the right to lodge a

complaint with the supervisory body competent for the protection of personal data (President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw).

7. In a situation where the processing of personal data is based on the consent of the data subject, providing your personal data to the Administrator is voluntary.

8. Your data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be profiled.

§7 Final provisions

1. Hereby regulations apply to the participant and the Organizer from the date of registering the participant for the Conference until the Organizer performs all activities related to the Conference.
